April 13, 14 & 15, 2012 at the J. Paul Getty Museum at the Getty Villa, Malibu, California

CONFERENCE GOAL:

To bring together colleagues within the museum and commercial sector of the collection care profession who work under the professional titles of Preparator; Art/Artifact Handler, Specialized Technician, Mountmaker, Storage Manager or similar title. The presentations will focus on these specific responsibilities of the Preparator to technical aspects of his or her role and relationship to other Collection Care colleagues: Conservators, Registrars, Curators, Collection Managers, Directors, Artists and Collectors.

The prime achievement of the 2009 Preparators Conference was the fostering of new relationships between fellow preparators. The conference is designed to educate, build professional relationships and promote the importance of Preparators as collection care professionals.

PRESENTATION TOPICS:

- The latest methods and materials related to Installation, Packing and Handling of art and artifacts.
- Exhibition case design and fabrication within institutions and for traveling exhibitions.
- Lighting design and techniques including current research and buying guidelines for LED lighting.
- Forums on worker health and safety, communication between collection care staff, training and professional staff outreach.
- Sunday site visits to other museums / commercial facilities.
